

## Working through accreditation levels at your own pace

**Schools are not required to purchase the support available if they satisfy the criteria for the appropriate levels; they can proceed straight to the accreditation process.**

- If required, training can be tailored to individual or group of schools' needs.
- The accreditation process will offer schools the opportunity for a subject review and includes a learning walk, lesson observation(s) and scrutiny of produced evidence (which can be submitted electronically for review, should the school require).
- On an annual basis, schools will require a review of the existing accreditation unless they are working towards the next level.

### What happens when you apply?

- Your school will be contacted by the Languages Adviser to discuss and agree the next steps to achieve Linguamarque.
- The adviser will send you the supporting documentation for achievement of the target level: evidence portfolio record sheet.
- When you are ready, you contact the Languages Adviser to arrange the review and accreditation visit.
- During the visit, the Languages Adviser will review the portfolio of evidence with the Subject Coordinator and carry out supporting evaluations.

- Subject to successful demonstration of target performance, the Languages Adviser will award your school the Marque.
- If some target criteria have not been demonstrated, you will be offered advice on next steps and strategies.
- When your school receives a Linguamarque certificate, you can use the Linguamarque logo on all correspondence and paperwork.
